There are fourteen hypotheses that the book proposes based on the study and each hypothesis is accompanied with policy suggestions. Interestingly, one of the hypotheses is that arbitrariness of government policies creates more problems and, as such,

before proposing a policy change the government needs to put in more effort and time in planning and come up with carefully chalked out processes.
