New aspects of ageing are discussed in the context of the free radical theory of ageing. This book is recommended as a

comprehensive introduction to the field for students, educators, clinicians, and researchers. It will also be an invaluable companion to all those interested in the role of free radicals in the life and biomedical sciences.
