Frente a la reducida visión de los especialistas, Rudolf Wittkower pone de relieve en esta obra cómo las diferentes culturas del este y el oeste pueden

inspirarse recíprocamente sin por ello perder su originalidad. Esta peculiar «migración de los símbolos» la estudia Wittkower en la difusión mundial del motivo de «el águila y la serpiente» y, sobre todo, en las maravillas, monstruos y portentos que, vistos o imaginados en oriente, según el testimonio de Megástenes, Marco Polo y otros viajeros, pasaron a ser parte de la cultura europea.
