But quite

remarkably, at the end of the semester, with my systematic analysis, my students end up liking the course, and it becomes a favourite course to them in all institutions where I have worked. Hence I decided to publish my lecture notes in the form of a textbook. The ultimate aim of this book is to: "Provide students with knowledge, skills and confidence required in understanding cost and management accounting for both accounting and non-accounting students at the university degree and professional examination levels." The primary focus is to discuss fundamentals of costing to form a solid foundation to management accounting courses at undergraduate, post-graduate and professional examination levels. The areas covered are presented in clear English language with clear and helpful layouts and formats on how to solve questions on a systematic and consistent basis.
