potential. I will analyse
why it initially appears
subversive and whether
or not it lives up to this
impression. This will
involve an examination of
the educational and
political system of the

wizarding world. I will
have a look at the
concept of family that the
novels promote, and
questions of gender will
be raised. The central
question is: what does it
mean to be different in
the wizarding world? Is
the wizarding world more
open to otherness than
the Muggle world seems
