The band, formed by sixteen-year-old Vernon Hopkins, was to play something called rock and roll, the fresh musical import from America. From practising in his parents' front room to a reputation as the best band in south Wales took just a year. But by 1961 they were in need of a new singer. Vernon

recruited local boy Tommy Woodward, and the rest is history. Or is it? This is a classic tale of rock and roll.
