Songeons que La Roue de Abel Gance a été crée où Gaumont Palace en 1923 avec un orchestre symphonique qui interprétait la composition originale de Arthur Honegger... Vers 1926, le cinéma sonore a d'abord été uniquement sonore. Quand on expérimenta les premiers synchronismes avec des microsillons, c'était uniquement avec de la musique. Ensuite, il y aura des chansons, de la musique et des paroles, d'où la formule qu'on voyait sur les affiches : " 100% sonore et parlant ! ". J'ai toujours connu et aimé la musique de cinéma. Quand j'étais enfant il y avait beaucoup de chansons dans les films français, chantées par Danièle Darrieux ou Jean Gabin et sont apparus les grands compositeurs. Maurice Joubert a été la première grande "plume" du cinéma français. Hélas, il fut tué dans les

premiers jours de la guerre en 1939. Il avait écrit la magnifique musique de L'Atalante de Jean Vigo, la si jolie valse de Carnet de bal de Julien Duvivier... Il est évident qu'à partir du moment où le cinéma est devenu sonore, les réalisateurs ont eu le plaisir de demander à des compositeurs de travailler pour eux et de leur écrire des musiques originales. A l'image de mon expérience avec Gérard Calvi, c'est là où se noue cette amitié constructive si bénéfique à un film, qui lie un réalisateur à un compositeur. Pierre Tchernia.

Moreover, translations are the prime instrument in the distribution of literature across linguistic and cultural borders; thus, they pave the way for gaining prestige in the world of literature. The thirty-eight papers included in this volume and dedicated to research in this area were previously read at the ICLA conference 2016 in Vienna. They are ample proof that the field remains at the center of interest in Comparative Literature.

They used creative expression as the vehicle to attain what André Breton called the "supreme point," the point at which all opposites cease to be perceived as contradictions. This supreme point is found at the heart of all esoteric doctrines, including the Great Work of alchemy, and enables communication with higher states of being. Drawing on an extensive range of writings by the surrealists and those in their circle of influence, Patrick Lepetit shows how the surrealists employed mythology, gnostic principles, tarot, voodoo, and alchemy not simply as reference points but as significant elements of their ongoing investigations into the fundamental nature of consciousness.
