It must be understood by the owner that the advances are of a sexual nature, and when you don't respond appropriately (to their way of thinking,) they become offended and nippy. Another breeding behavior common with this species is regurgitation. During breeding season they will often leave a white, pasty coat of regurgitation of their favorite toys, requiring extra cleaning efforts from their owners. This is not to imply in any way the the indian ringneck is a poor choice for those looking for a parrot to love they just require companionship in a different way than other birds. The indian ringneck needs an owner that
