The nightmare came to an end."In this enthralling memoir, the author recounts his experiences of the war years and traces the story of the ace fighter pilots from the German development of radar to the Battle of Britain. Johnen flew his first operational mission in July 1941, having completed his blind-flying training. In his first couple of years he brought down two enemy planes. The

tally went up rapidly once the air war was escalated in spring 1943, when Air Marshal Arthur Harris of the RAF Bomber Command began the campaign dubbed the Battle of the Ruhr. During this phase of the war Johnens successes were achieved against a 710-strong force of bombers. Johnens further successes during Harris's subsequent offensive led to his

promotion as Staffelkapitan (squadron leader) of Nachtjagdgeschwader and a move to Mainz. During a sortie from there, his Bf 110 was hit by return fire and he was forced to land in Switzerland. He and his crew were interned by the authorities. The Germans were deeply worried about leaving a sophisticatedly equipped night fighter and its important air crew in the hands of a foreign

government, even if it was a neutral one. After negotiations involving Gring, the prisoners were released. John's unit moved to Hungary and by October 1944 his score was standing at 33 aerial kills. His final one came in March the following year, once John had moved back to Germany.

Nevertheless, in the images caught and fixed so sharply here, Harbutt transcends this tradition, not by denying it, but by bridging the gap between the abstract or & "pure&" photograph

and the documentary statement. Although the book does not follow the too-prevalent narrative documentary pattern in which visual statements are in part determined by a preconceived verbal scenario, still the progression of the images reveals consistencies of theme and structure that are appropriate to a genuine book, as opposed to an exhibit of photographs

unrelated except by quality that is reproduced in book format. The book is absolutely &"literate&" in terms of the photographic medium itself: formal values and content are so totally fused that one is able to &"read&" it many times and find deeper meanings each time. The subject matter Harbutt looks at and into is common to the experience of us all&-but he sees it in an intensely

uncommon, personal way, and in turn he allows us to share in his vision. The first three sections of the book reveal the World, the Flesh, and the Devil. &"The World&" brings the inanimate to life&-automobiles and buses and buildings are seen largely in isolation from their human context and assume a reality and animation all their own. &"The Flesh&" is a revelation of pure humanity&-children are

The book first elaborates on matrices, groups, and representations. Topics include abstract properties, applications, matrix groups,

key theorem of representation theory, properties of character tables, simply reducible groups, tensors and invariants, and representations generated by functions. The text then examines applications and subgroups and representations, as well as subduced and induced representations, fermion annihilation and creation operators, crystallographic point groups,

proportionality tensors in crystals, and nonrelativistic wave equations. The publication takes a look at space group representation s and energy bands, symmetric groups, and applications.
