The relentless firestorm ultimately trapped his hotshot brothers, tragically killing all 19 of them

within minutes. Nationwide, it was the greatest loss of firefighter lives since the 9/11 attacks. to armed robber to dangerous potential killer, and discloses for the first time how he used his underworld connections and know-how as a secret, Boston-based operative for the Irish Republican Army.
